JOB DESCRIPTION

Basketball Pacific (BBP) Koru Coach

Reports to: Basketball Pacific Mentor Coaches

All Age-groups

General attributes required

- Be committed and enthusiastic to be involved in BBP programmes
- Act as a positive ambassador and spokesperson for BBP and BBP Programmes
- Have good communication skills
- Have good team building skills
- Be willing to work as a member of a team, within the BBP coaching community
- Be willing to share information and experiences to other members of the basketball coaching community.
- Seek and involve self in development opportunities

Basketball attributes required:

- Technical and tactical knowledge required for the level of position applied for.
- Either coaching or playing experience at a similar or higher level of than the position applied for.
- Knowledge of the required skill and training levels for elite athletes relevant to the position applied for.
- Ability to design a season plan / master plan, which will form a base to plan practise sessions from.

Basketball Pacific general requirements:

- Understand that the Basketball Pacific programme has a no recruitment policy. Coaches must not attempt to recruit representative players to any school, club or programme they are involved in.
- Run trials in accordance with Basketball Pacific guidelines.
- Coach the team at ALL events entered by Basketball Pacific – please see *draft* calendar attached.
- Not book or agree to any training sessions for rep teams unless agreed to by the Director of Development.
- Be a willing and proactive supporter of all BBP Programmes.
- Understand the bigger picture of player development and that this is a long-term process.
- Attend coaching meetings as required at Camps and on Tour.
- Two weeks after the conclusion of the team's games on tour submit a written report of the season.
- Be aware of and be able to follow Basketball New Zealand's Coaches Code of Conduct
- Wear BBP apparel at all BBP programme and development programme sessions.
- Be willing to undertake learning in the role of a mentee (i.e. be open to feedback from mentors).
- Be willing to mentor assistant coaches (if any)

Please note: BBP will provide support and training for areas where coaches require assistance.
BBP reserves the right to remove coaches who fail to meet the above requirements.
